Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been established in the college on 28/02/2013 by the hands of Dr. Sudhir Patil, Ex-Vice-Chancellor Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Dr. S. E. Pawar, Scientist BARC, Mumbai and every activity is monitored through it. Accordingly every activity is performed through action plan prepared by IQAC at the beginning of every session and action taken report is prepared. NAAC has been a guiding force for the present and future programmes, functions and activities. As per the suggestions of the Peer Team, the college has taken many measures to enhance the quality of higher education.

Significant Activities and Contributions made by IQAC during the last session can be enumerated as follows:

- Teacher diary and daily notes diaries are provided to faculties which are evaluated periodically by HoD and Principal.
- Surprise visit of IQAC coordinator /principal to class room.
- Academic Calendar is prepared at the beginning of the session and evaluated at the end of session by IQAC.
- Teaching Plans have been submitted by respective departments to IQAC and action is taken accordingly.
- IQAC evaluates performance of students through 02 Unit Tests and 02 Terminal Exams.
- Students are motivated to prepare and present Research Papers related to topics and as a result number of students presented and submitted their Research Papers, Articles in various Proceedings.
- IQAC also collects annual reports from the departments and evaluate their performance and progress.

Initiatives of the IQAC in Sensitizing/Promoting Research Climate in the institution:

- IQAC regularly motivates faculties to apply for research grants projects and grants to UGC/DST/DBT etc. (including GOs and NGOs).
